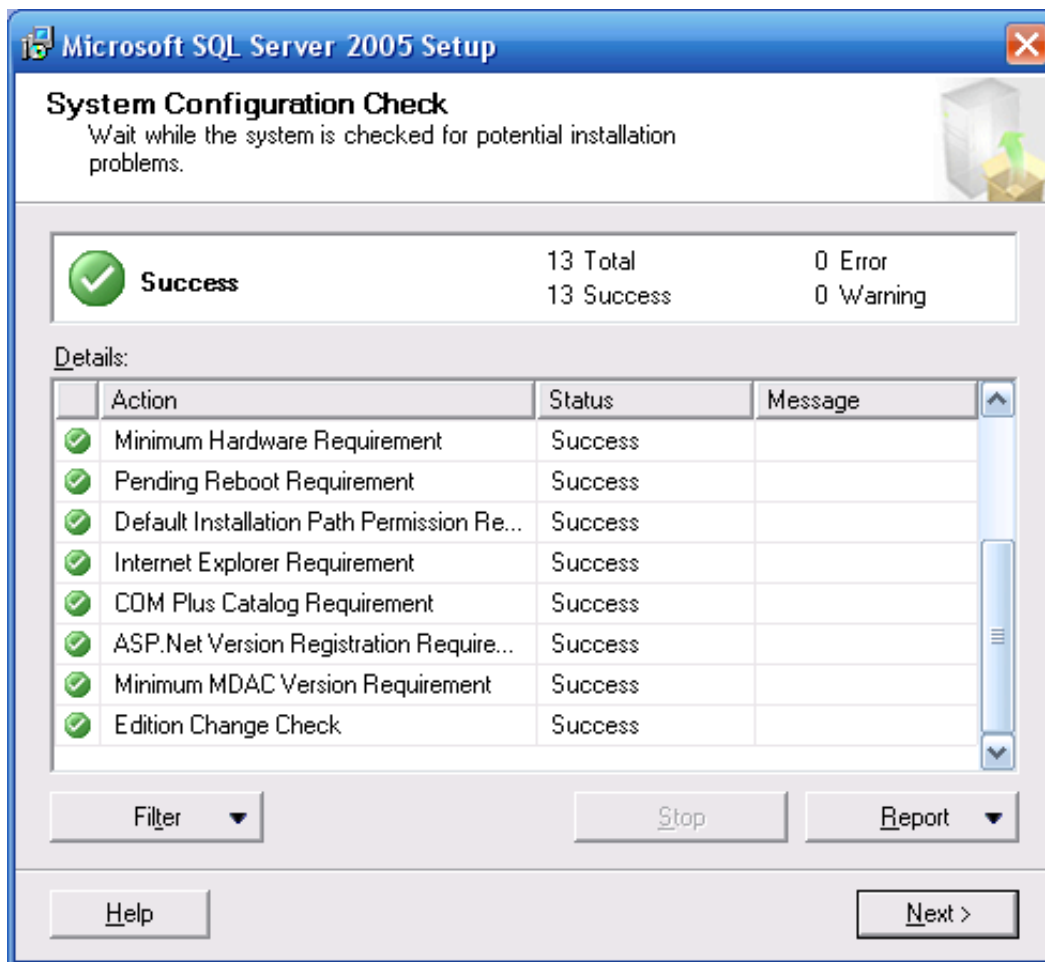



Installing SQL Server 2005 Express for Focus 2

1. Run the SQL Server 2005 install package. After it has checked your system, ensure that *System Configuration Check* looks like this:



Click the **Next** button.

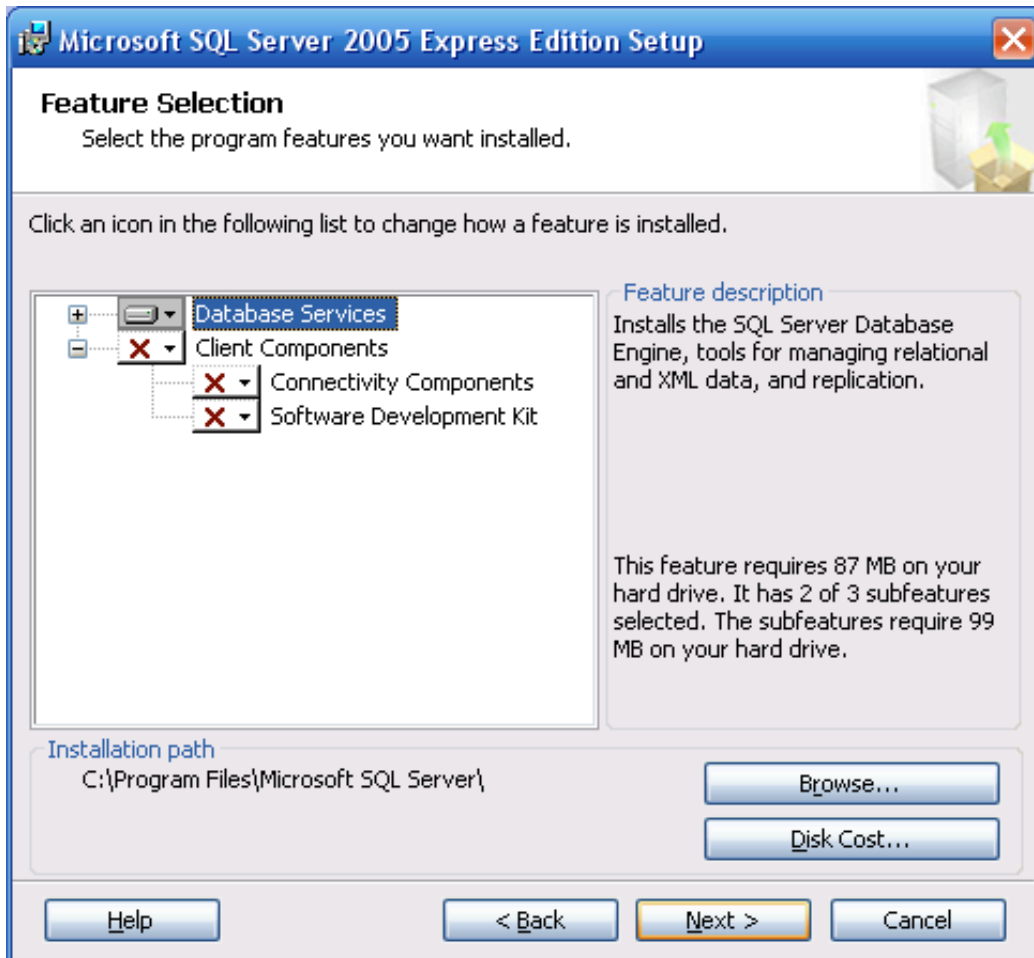
2. Fill in the required *Name* and *Company* then un-check the *Hide the Advanced configuration options* checkbox:

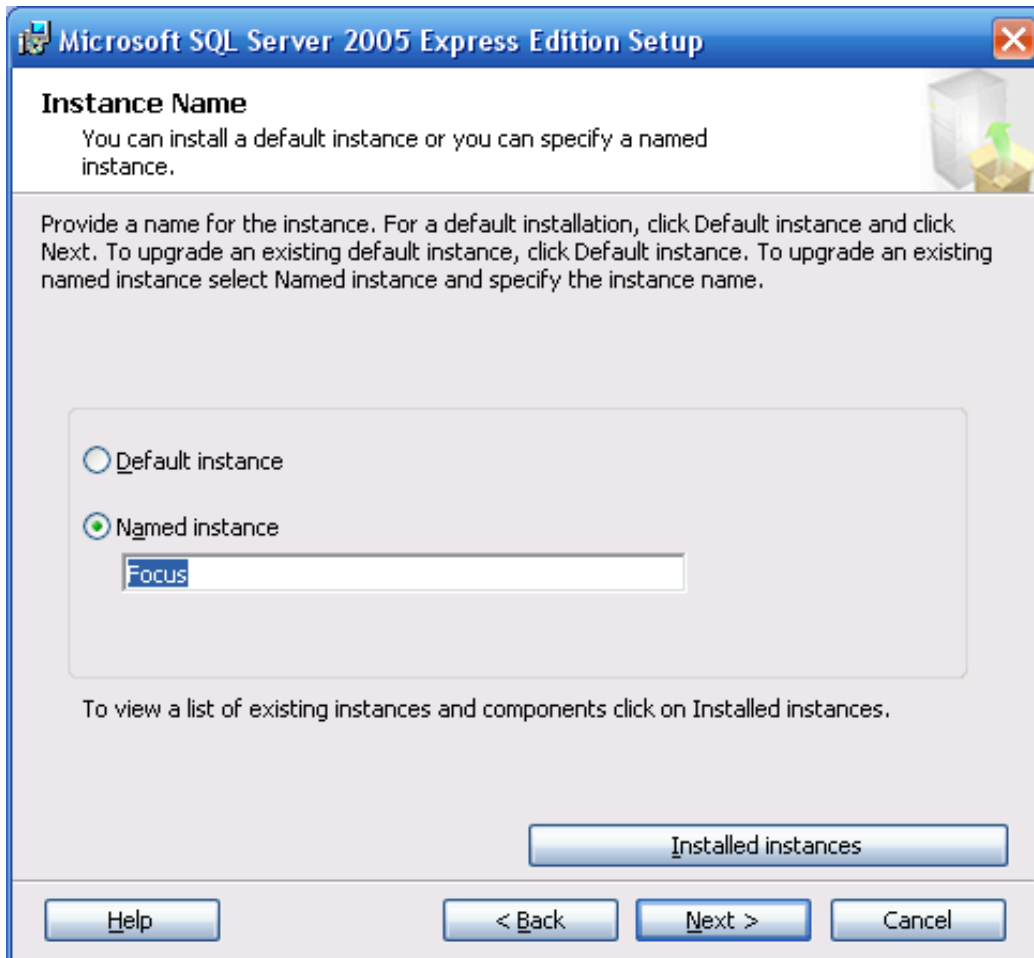
Click the **Next** button.

3. Ensure that the *Feature Selection* looks like this:



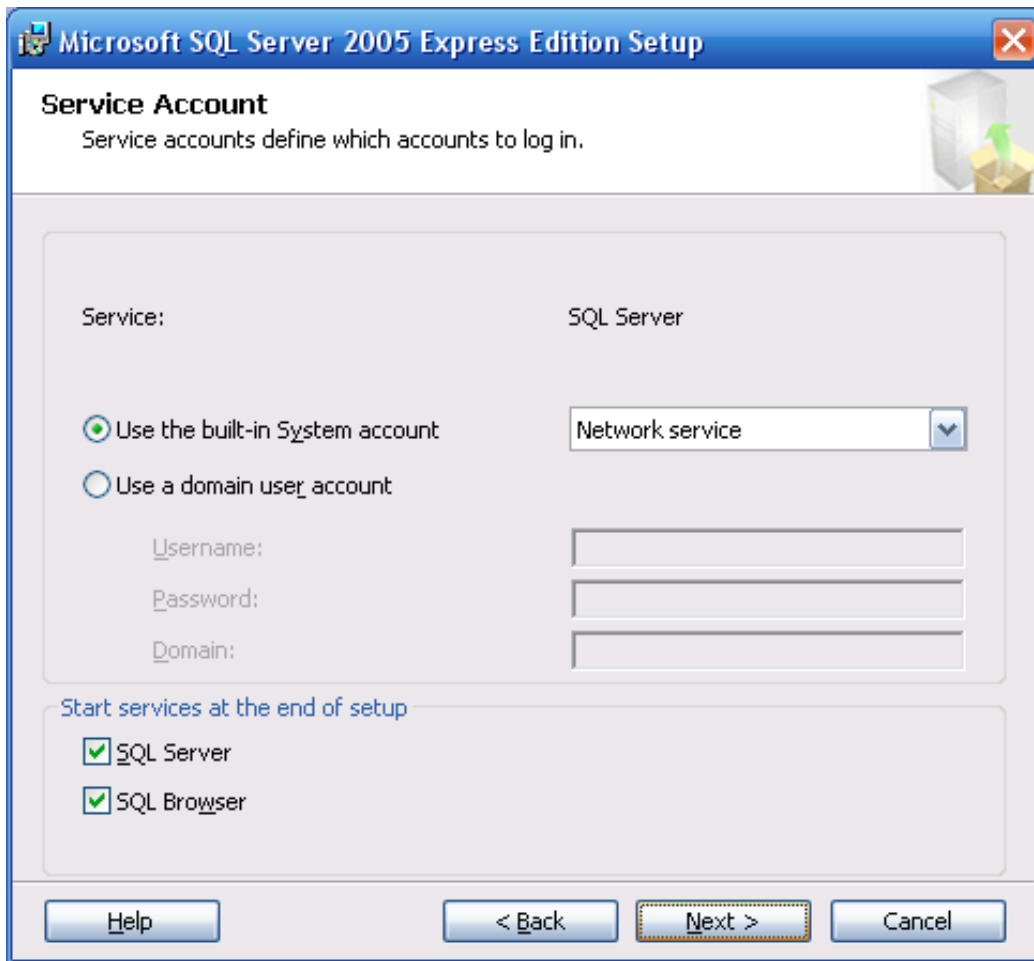
Click the **Next** button.

4. Select a *Named Instance* and call it 'Focus':



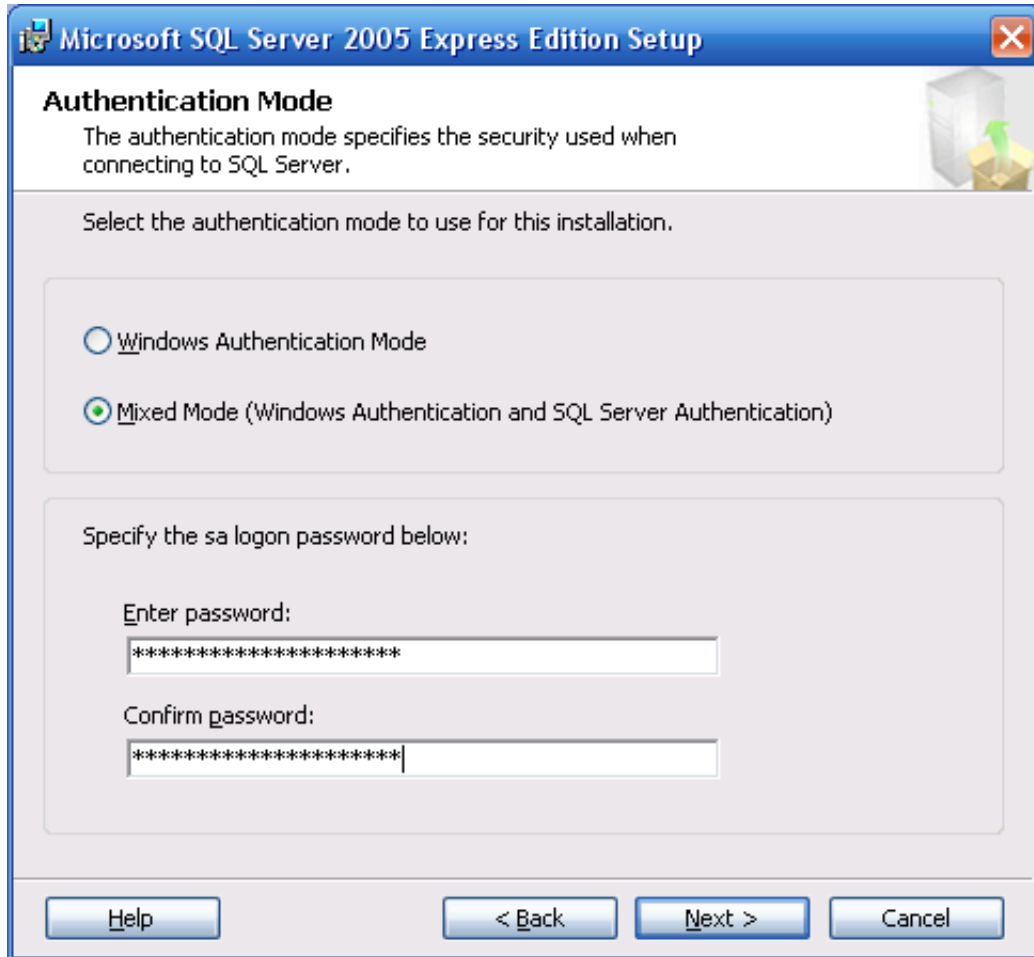
Click on the **Next** button.

5. Ensure that *Service Account* looks like this:



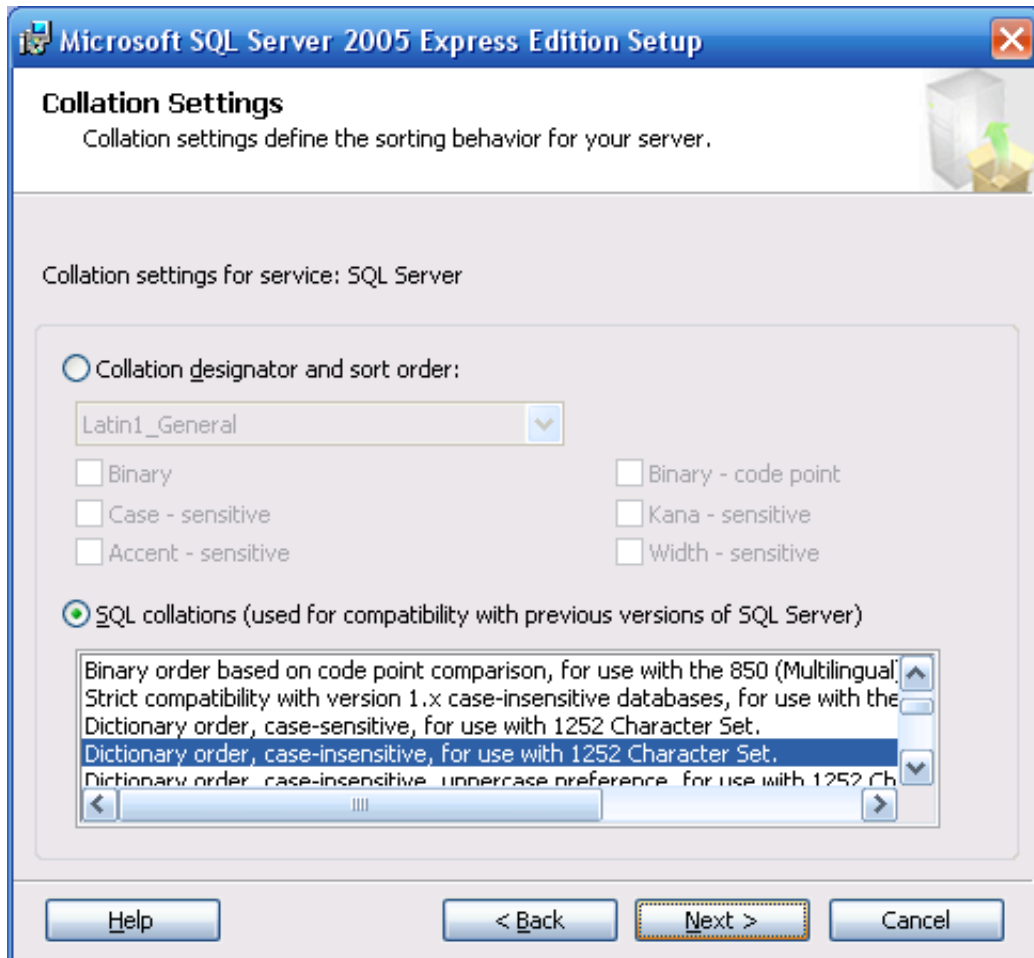
Click the **Next** button.

6. Ensure that *Authentication Mode* looks like this and that you enter the desired sa logon password (write this down for future reference):



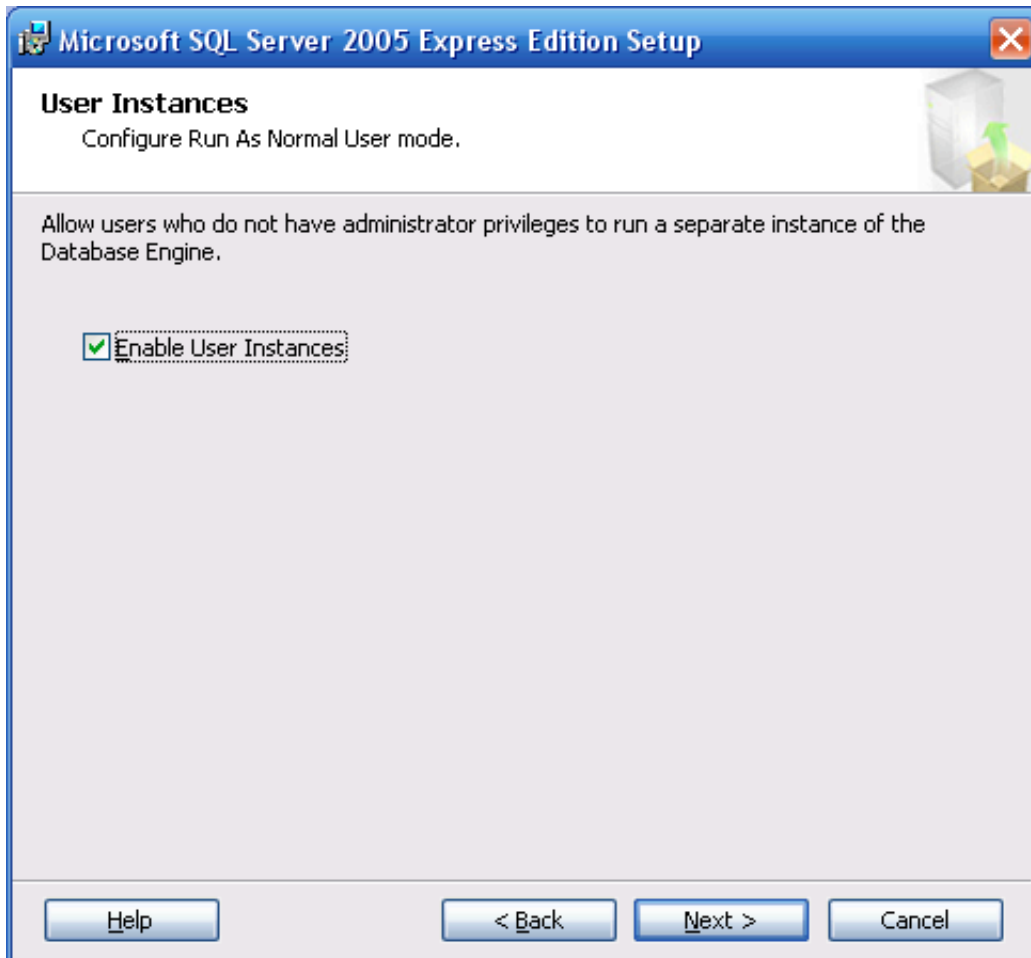
Click the **Next** button.

7. Ensure that *Collation Settings* look like this:



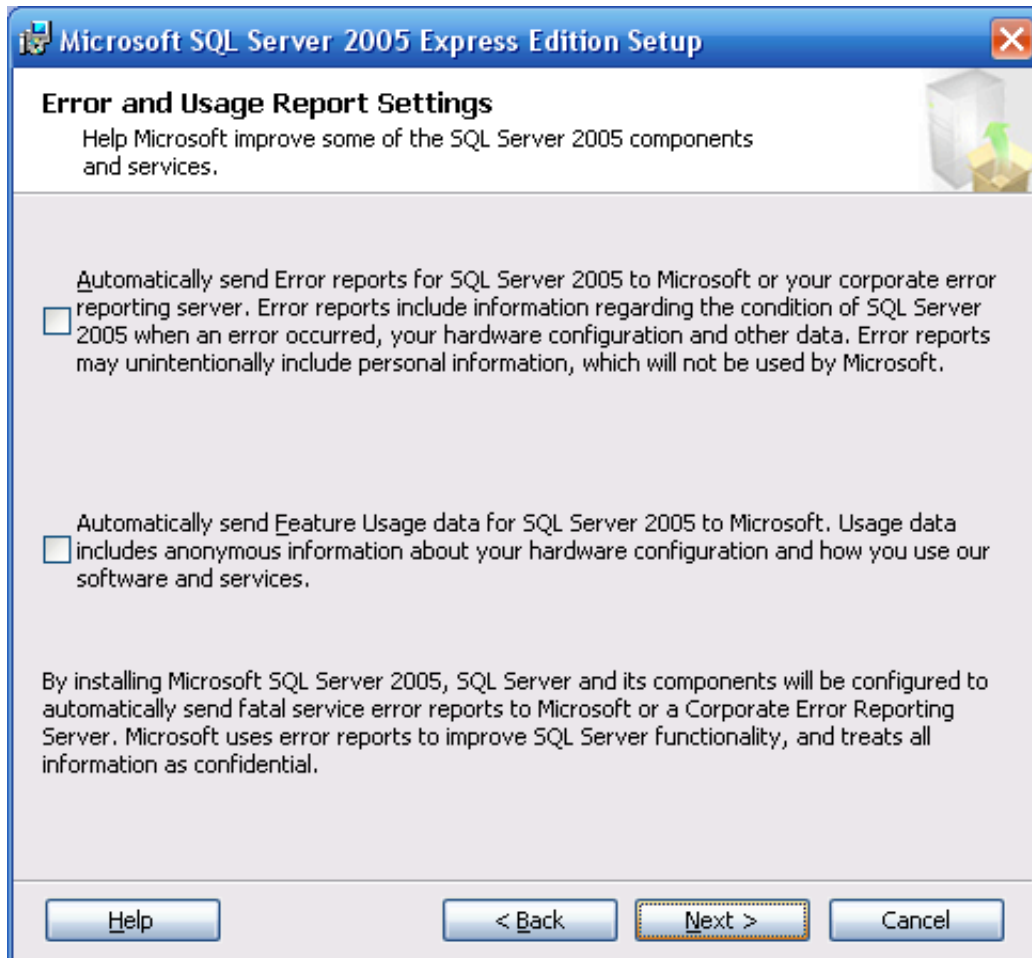
Click the **Next** button.

8. Ensure that *User Instances* looks like this:



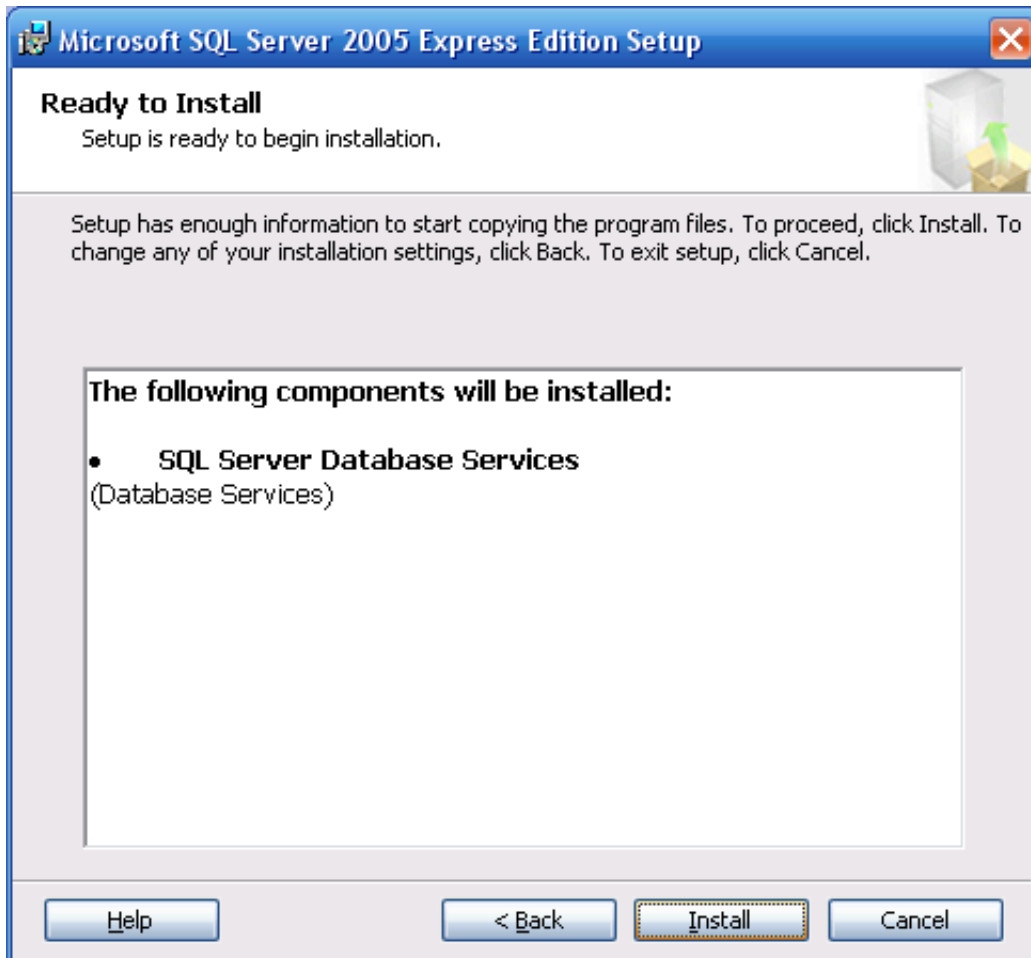
Click the **Next** button.

Click the **Next** button.

9. Ensure that *Ready to Install* looks like this:



Click the *Install* button. SQL will now be installed with a named instance of Focus.
